Barely a year after opening more than 500,000 SF of new facilities, Cook Children's Medical Center in Fort Worth, TX is expanding again. David M. Schwarz Architects (DMSAS) is currently finishing Detailed Design for a new, six-story, 314,000 SF tower. The addition will house a new Medical Lab, Emergency Department, Surgery Suite with 12 operating rooms and IMRI, Heart Center, and two floors of expansion space for future inpatient beds. The project is being delivered through an Integrated Project Delivery (IPD) method consisting of 11 primary collaborative project team partners.

The entire project will cost \$349 Million, including a Utility Plant and Urgent Care Center. Preliminary site work has begun and the new tower is slated to open in 2017.
